*The City of Corcoran does its best to be proactive as possible while doing Municipal Code Enforcement. The most common way the City does this is by sending Notices of Violation to the property owners. These letters generally do not have administrative citations or fines attached to them unless the violation is a severe health and safety risk to the residence, citizens or visitors of the City of Corcoran, or a violation concerning water waste. However, if the property owner does not abate the violation in the time given on the Notice and Order, citation and fines will follow.*

*The most common violations include:*

- 1. Water waste, watering on the wrong day or time*
- 2. Unkempt lawns and landscape (weeds, lawns in need of mowing, overgrowth)*
- 3. Alley cleanup: (Weeds, garbage, trash items, overgrowth of shrubs and trees)*
- 4. Items stored in public view*
- 5. Abandon or unused vehicles*
- 6. Cars parked illegally (on the lawn or on dirt areas)*
- 7. Sub-Standard buildings*

*The City Municipal Code, property maintenance and Code Enforcement is in place to help maintain property values and provide a safe, clean neighborhoods. Let us all encourage one another and help our neighbors by friendly conversations so that we all can enjoy and be proud of the City we call home.*

*While these Code Enforcement sweeps canvass different parts of the City on a weekly basis, we cannot be in all areas of the City at the same time. If you see a possible code violation that needs attention, please contact the Community Development Department at 559-992-2151 ext. 225*
